associated with the rule. When the state diagram diagram is set up, a pair of public constants is available for each state machine that can be assigned to the Rule. When the user enters a state machine, the rules associated with that state machine change into the new state. ?

wants, or should it be designed for the developers needs? Should the focus be on the end result or be on the details? The designer's workflow is a critical step in understanding the outcome of a design, and is used to determine the appropriate level of

detail to be included in your application. The designer makes decisions based on the business needs of the application, as well as the needs of the team developing the application. The designer needs to determine if the application needs to be developed in a light-weight,

Rule Manager is a set of tools designed to allow business users (without IT staff) to author and maintain a set of business rules without programming or design. These rules govern the application of logic against incoming messages. Rules

perform computations, apply conditions and produce an output. They act like mini-code and developers can create their own rules in any .NET language, without programming. Business rules and business terms are modeled and edited by the business user in a rule editor. A term

is a piece of text,
and a rule is a set
of conditions and
actions. A rule is
logical combination
of terms and
conditions. Rules
make decisions for
the application of
logic, control data
flows through the
application, and
